The HART Outreach Service is a Primary Care Health Service provided by Rochdale Health Alliance (RHA) for the homeless and transient community within our borough.

From Tuesday 1 September 2020, the HART Outreach service will be launched to provide clinical interventions & assessments supported by two nurses and a liaison officer.

Our initial drop-in sessions are listed below and will be updated as the service develops. We are also ensuring our clinical sessions fully comply with Covid-19 regulations.
